Seeking reports on: (sick or dead)

- Poultry (commercial and residential)
- Domesticated waterfowl (geese, ducks, swans)
- Doves, quail, pigeons
- Pet birds (for a fee)
- Backyard chicken owners may submit their dead chicken (\$25 fee)

**Tests for:**

- Avian Influenza (as indicated)
- Newcastle disease

Seeking reports on: (sick or dead)

- Wild birds (free-ranging)
- Increased mortality (5 or more) wild birds
- Endangered, threatened, or protected wild bird species

**Tests/examines for:**

- Postmortem examination
- Testing may include:
  - Infectious diseases
  - Other pathogens
  - Pesticide exposure
  - West Nile virus
  - Avian Influenza

Seeking reports on: (dead only)

- Corvids, other songbirds, and raptors
- Other such as shorebirds, woodpeckers, hummingbirds (tested in some areas)

**Tests for:**

- West Nile virus
